- Partake in the daily operations meeting with the OIM and other rig department heads.
- In relation to the rig's trim and stability requirements, communicate with the Chief Engineer regarding the disposition, loading, ordering and use of fuel, potable and drill water.
- Administer rig's continuous surveys and renewal of statutory certificates as required by Classification Society and statutory regulations.
- Ensure the rig's navigational equipment is maintained, fully functional and that testing and calibration is carried out in accordance with Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) regulations.
- Maintain the rig's logbook, maintenance reports and other documents as directed.
- Capable of performing DP incident investigation.

QHSE:

- Ensure all life saving and fire fighting equipment are inspected, tested and maintained ensu readiness for immediate use when required.
- Ensure compliance with environmental protections requirements as specified by Company pc and Regulatory bodies.
- Ensure that the Company QHSE policies and other programs are communicated to and under by all rig personnel.
- Play an active part in the weekly meetings, Quality Improvement Plan program, and all other company safety management systems.
- Ensure new arrivals receive a full safety briefing and inductions on the rig.
- Ensure a high standard of hygiene and housekeeping is maintained onboard the rig.
- Coordinate weekly emergency drills along with monitoring and evaluating the deck crew resp
- Respond to all emergency protection responses as designated on the station bill.

Personnel:

- Competent to train new DP personnel, and assess the skill level of new and existing DP personnel.
- Meets the training requirements as per the applicable training matrix
- Mentor, develop and train crew members to ensure they are competent to work at their next job level.
- Ensure proper and relevant communication with all personnel.
- Ensure compliance with the minimum manning level in accordance with Flag Society and International Maritime regulations.
- Maintain discipline onboard and ensure compliance with Company and regulatory disciplinary procedures.
- Ensure all marine department personnel get an annual performance appraisal. Recommend promotion or disciplinary action up to and including discharge.
