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So I have their agreement that what we will do is take the USGS result and the result from the flow modeling group, and provide our best estimate of the minimum rate of release of the Deepwater Horizon well. So for example, I don't have the exact numbers yet, but we might say something like, "Multiple lines of scientific evidence agree that the rate of release is at least 14,000 to 20,000 barrels of oil per day." We believe that a statement like this will be much more helpful to emergency responders than the current 5000 barrels per day, is honest, and yet is not as alarmist as the 70,000 barrels that has been picked up by the media and is demonstrably wrong.
