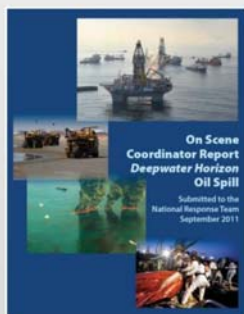


U.S. Government Conclusions: Successful Mitigation of Potential Health Impacts
