 The upcoming skimmer report will include updates on procurement and delivery status, including availability of vessels to install this equipment upon.

1. The remaining 4 vessels will be COMBATANT (one Transrec 15% on foreign vessels (UK/Norway primarily) and will then be the GOM. This is a two week turn. These will likely require Jones Act seafarers. Expect an update tomorrow.
 2. There are five MRSC responder class vessels remaining on the west coast. They all carry a Transrec. BP and the Coast Guard agree these are a last resort, and as mentioned above we began conversations about moving 3 today. Each would come with a large ocean barge.
 3. There is one MRSC skimmer and barge in San Juan, Puerto Rico that again is a last resort choice. Number 6 & 7

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
