

ment decline in Non-Panhandle Florida Gulf Coast counties. Based on average 2009 employment levels in these three regions, these statistically significant estimated impacts translate into about 3,000 more jobs in the oil parishes, 3,000 more jobs in the Alabama coastal counties, and 50,000 fewer jobs in the Florida coastal counties reflecting the net effects of the spill, spill response, and moratorium.
