To All,

Effective 26th January, the new Risk Management Recommended Practice (RP) takes effect and shall be implemented across GoM D&C.

All project and rig teams shall commence transitioning over to the risk process as defined within this RP, and shall commence transferring risks over to the new version of bpRAT – the tool selected to manage all D&C Risks. All risks are to be reviewed, updated and validated prior to transfer.

All teams are expected to complete the transition process by the end of March 2010 and, from that point forward, manage their risks and associated actions within bpRAT.

Over the course of the next few weeks Kal Jassal and his project team will provide teams with the necessary Risk Management RP overview, training, and technical support to facilitate the transition process. Please contact him and arrange a convenient time for him to meet with you and your respective teams.

The Recommended Practice is issued as an “Implementation Draft”, with final issue planned for March 2010 once feedback from the implementation process is incorporated into the document.
