We currently have 756 sacks of cement on the rig and about 1300 sacks of cement on the Dante. I'm waiting to get the MT from the cementer to verify the amount of sacks on the Dante, but I've been told it is 1300 sacks. I should have copy of MT from cementer by the morning. I've spoken to Jasen Bradley the cementing Account Representative at ENI and he stated to me that they cannot use this blend of cement because they will be foaming the riserless sections. In a conversation this morning with Jimmy Adams, he stated that Tom Shackleford spoke to someone at ENI who said they would take the cement. I asked who the contact was at ENI and Jimmy did not know who Tom spoke to. At this point I'm not counting on ENI to take the cement so I have spoken to Joe Edwards who watches over the DD II and he said that he can use the cement as long as the drilling team is willing to take it off our hands. The cement is Prem + .07% EZ-Flo + .25% D-Air 3000 + 1.88 lb/sk KCL. This cement can be used for any jobs lower the 220 deg static. This cement cannot be used when foaming because of the D-Air in the blend.

I have sent Jasen Bradley the chemical inventory currently on the rig. The easiest this to do with the chemical is to transfer it to ENI. I'm waiting to hear back from Jasen to verify he can use what is currently on the rig. If there are some additives he cannot use then we can return any unopened additives to the Halliburton bulk plant for credit.
