Next step is to run WB on dedicated run to ensure clear then re run drift run with bit to bottom of casing to ensure clear for casing inspection log and BSR test.

Subject: Any of you guys ever fish casing centralizers from a well - namely the wellhead?
I am sure most of you know we could not get our casing pass our sidetrack interval on the DC 314 well. Once we came out of the hole with the casing we left 5 total centralizers and associated stop rings in the hole along with a total of 18 blades. Most of the drag was in the open hole and some in the bottom portion of the casing. We tried to run back in with a 12-1/4" bit to push them out in open hole but could not get pass the wellhead. We are currently pulling out of the hole and will run a magnet while we wait on fishing tools. Long shot but gives us something to do. Was wondering if any of you had the pleasure of fishing these things before and could give some pointers...yeah I know this is why we used to not run any on a floating rig.
