SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS: DEFINING ACTUAL AND POTENTIAL HARM

- Actual harm: Demonstrated effect that altered the normal functions and populations in an ecosystem
 - Observations in the field of harmed resources (e.g., oiled birds, oiled marsh)
- Potential harm: Evidence suggests that there might be harm, but does not unambiguously demonstrate it
 - Evidence of known causes of harm to resources (e.g., surface oil distribution, oil concentrations in surface waters, toxicity studies)
