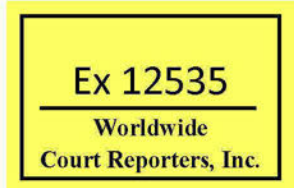

Craig,
At 1000 today we have at VTC with the DWH FOSCs (which make up most of the FOSC Report Steering Committee). We are outlining / agreeing to the work ahead to include in the FOSC Report. We are parsing out the work, issue by issue, so that contributors (mostly CG right now) with the best perspective(s) can draft comments. The issue of solvency of the RP during a SONS, and related issues on adequacy of access, size, and applicability of the OSLTF (and emergency fund) to cover the response actions of a spill like DWH is worthy of comment. Is this something you and NPFC can help us with, Craig?

Also, I did not think to add you onto our Steering Committee for the FOSC Report, but we would absolutely welcome your presence if it does not detract from your work. We plan to hold a bi-weekly VTC to keep the FOSC's up-to-speed and otherwise stay on track with the FOSC Report.

And one final note...the capacity that includes the solvency of the RP during a SONS is paramount. The claims process alone would have eaten our lunch had BP and eventually the GCCF not stepped up to the plate. Response costs to date have blown through the \$12b ceiling with no end in sight and our OSLTF constraints are not going to answer the mail in a 21st century SONS absent a solvent and cooperative RP. pfz
