Dr. Wes Tunnell – Primary Conclusions

- Based upon extensive Government data (collected over several decades), post-spill population levels are within historical ranges and trends for fish, shellfish and birds.
- The Deepwater Horizon oil spill did not cause significant adverse effects to fish, shellfish or bird populations in the Gulf of Mexico.
- There is no evidence of significant or large-scale population effects to turtles, dolphins or coral.
